## First Aid Kit

2 absorbent compress dressings (5 x 9 inches)  
25 adhesive bandages (assorted sizes)  
1 adhesive cloth tape (10 yards x 1 inch)  
5 antibiotic ointment packets (approx. 1 gram)  
5 antiseptic wipe packets  
2 packets of aspirin (81 mg each)  
1 emergency blanket  
1 breathing barrier (with one-way valve)  
1 instant cold compress  
2 pair of nonlatex gloves (size: large)  
2 hydrocortisone ointment packets (approx. 1 gram each)  
1 3 in. gauze roll (roller) bandage  
1 roller bandage (4 inches wide)  
5 3 in. x 3 in. sterile gauze pads  
5 sterile gauze pads (4 x 4 inches)  
Oral thermometer (non-mercury/non-glass)  
2 triangular bandages  
Tweezers  
Emergency First Aid instructions
